

AU men's swimming team defeats Fredonia; women's team falls

FREDONIA, NY The Alfred University men's swimming and diving team ran its winning streak in dual meets to 16 with a 141-102 victory over host Fredonia Friday evening. The AU women's team lost, 139-89. Juniors Brian Agro (Gray, ME/Cheverus), 1,000-yard freestyle and 100-yard breaststroke, and Matt Baker (Weedsport, NY/Weedsport), 200-yard freestyle and 100-yard backstroke, were each double-winners for the Saxons (4-0, 2-0 Empire 8). Other winners for the AU men's team were junior Mark Baker (Weedsport, NY/Weedsport), in the 50-yard freestyle; senior Page Beecher (Scarborough, ME/Scarborough), in the 400-yard individual medley; and freshman Tyler Olsen (Saratoga Springs, N Y/Saratoga), in the 100-yard freestyle. The team of Matt Baker, Agro, Beecher and Mark Baker won the 400-yard medley relay. Junior Jessie Caccamo (Ballston Lake, NY/Shenendehowa) earned a win in the 1,000-yard freestyle to pace the AU women. Other to swimmers for the women's team were freshman Cailin Asmo (Johnson City, NY/Johnson City), second in the 200-yard free; freshman Sarah Blair (Auburn, NY/Auburn), second in the 50-yard free; and senior Lyndsay Scypta (Plymouth, MI/Cranbrook-Kingswood), second in the 400-yard IM and third in the 100-yard breast. The team of Asmo, freshman Calista Merritt (Conesus, NY/Livonia), senior Kim Covino (Derby, NY/Lake Shore) and Caccamo placed second in the 400-yard freestyle relay. The AU men's and women's teams are in action next Nov. 30-Dec. 2 at the RIT Invitational.
