The teams were determined by conference swimmers' performance at last week's New York State Women's Collegiate Athletic Association (NYSWCAA) championship meet.Thompson was named First Team All-Empire 8 in the 100 breaststroke and 200 breaststroke. She won the state title in the 100 breaststroke and was runner-up in the 200 breaststroke.Two others from Alfred earned individual all-conference honors. Junior Lauren McCormack (Norwich/Norwich) was named to the Second Team in the 50 freestyle and freshman Erin Collins (Owego/Owego) was named to the Second Team in 3-meter diving.Two AU relay teams also garnered all-conference recognition.
