Reset Your Clocks, Replace Batteries, Sign Up for NYS Alert

It is that time of year to spring your clocks forward this weekend, replace your smoke alarm batteries and sign up for NYS Alert!

We can't help with the first two, but can we with the last one - NYS Alert! Employees can easily sign up through their BannerWeb account to be notified of an emergency situation on campus.

You will be able to receive e-mail, voice mail, cell phone, TEXT and/or fax alert messages.

It is easy and quick to register through BannerWeb. All you need to have handy is your Banner ID# and PIN.

Then just click on Personal Information tab and fill out the quick survey listed under Emergency Alert Contact Info.

If you are not sure of either your Banner ID# or PIN call the Help Desk at 2222 or call Denise Kirschner at 2602.

If you have already signed up for NYS Alert, please take the time to update your information if you have recently moved, changed offices or your cell phone number.
