Alfred, NY -- Adrian Morling, a native of England who came to the United States in 1984 and most recently worked in Buffalo, has been named assistant director of Information Technology Services at Alfred University. The appointment was announced by ITS Director Lana Meissner. Morling started his new job Jan. 3. Morling and his wife, Marcy Morling, bought a house in Canisteo, home of his wife's parents, Wayne and Nancy Hartman. Wayne Hartman has been athletic director for 29 years at Canisteo High School. A graduate of the DeVry Institute of Technology in Dallas, TX, Morling graduated in 1995 with highest honors and a Bachelor of Science in computer information systems. Since then, he's been working as a LAN (local area network) administrator, most recently at M&T Bank in Buffalo. His job at AU is slightly different, although it uses the same skills and knowledge. "This is a management and administrative position," Morling said. "I now have seven technicians reporting to me. We are responsible for personal-computer repairs and supporting all the network services such as the VAX system, email and web servers." Morling and his wife, who is completing her training at the State University at Buffalo as a Physical Therapist, are expecting their first child.
