

Alfred University welcomes Alfred State professor to environmental series

The Fall 2005 Environmental Studies Speaker Series at Alfred University welcomes Timothy Cochran, associate professor in the Electrical Engineering Technology Department at Alfred State College, who will present "An Off-Grid Home Using Natural Building Materials," on Friday, Sept. 30, at 12:20 p.m., in room 228 of the Science Center. Everyone is welcome and refreshments will be served. Cochran has held a strong interest in energy conservation since his undergraduate years. In 2001, he made the interest into a commitment in his six-member family's new home. The residence is powered by a wind turbine and photovoltaic cells, and has a wood frame with straw-bale infill and stucco exterior. The educator holds a masters degree in electrical engineering from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.
