

Lady Saxons nip Cazenovia, snap losing, scoreless streaks

The Alfred University women's soccer team defeated host Cazenovia College, 2-1, Saturday afternoon to snap a four-game losing streak during which the Lady Saxons had failed to score a goal. After Cazenovia opened the scoring with an unassisted goal by Barb Garlow five minutes into the game, AU (2-6-1, 0-4-1 Empire Eight) tied it eight minutes later when freshman Emily Packet (Chatham/Chatham) notched her first career goal. Packet was assisted by senior midfielder Charity Lord (Bath/Bath-Haverling). Another freshman, forward Stephanie Rudd (Jordanville/Owen D. Young), scored the gamewinner with just over four minutes left in the half on an assist from sophomore midfielder Jessica Montgomery (Limestone/Allegany-Limestone). It was also Rudd's first collegiate goal. The Lady Saxons outshot Cazenovia, 30-4. AU junior goaltender Sara Stephens (Wayland/Wayland-Cohocton) made two saves. Leah Pickett made 14 saves for Cazenovia (4-7). Alfred plays next on Tuesday, Oct. 3, at 4 p.m. at Fredonia.
