

Alfred University women's basketball falls to Nazareth College

ROCHESTER, NY - The Alfred University women's basketball team traveled to Rochester Friday evening, where they fell, 59-45, to Nazareth College in Empire 8 conference action. The Lady Saxons (5-13, 1-7 Empire 8) trailed by eight at halftime but were held to 20 points in the second half. Junior center Kylene Knoll (Elmira, NY/Elmira Free Academy) had a solid outing for AU, scoring 10 points and grabbing seven rebounds. Knoll also recorded three assists and three blocked shots on the night. Senior guard Michelle Kelly (Levittown, NY/General Douglas MacArthur) had the hot-hand from three-point territory, hitting 44 percent (4-9) of her shots behind the arc to finish with a team-high 12 points. Junior forward Meghan Coddington (Amherst, NH/Souhegan) and sophomore guard Denae Foster (Canaseraga, NY/Arkport) finished the game with nine and six rebounds respectively, while sophomore guard Megan Sampsell (Corry, PA/Corry Area) dished out a game-high five assists. Freshman forward Ali Sharpe (Rochester, NY/Aquinas Institute) had a double double for Nazareth (10-8, 3-5 Empire 8) with 12 points and 14 rebounds. Senior center Sara Shipley (Macedon, NY/Palmyra-Macedon) scored a game-high 17 points, grabbed six boards and had four blocked shots.
