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News About Your AU Student ID Card

Dear students,

AU and AVI Fresh, our dining services partner, are pleased to announce that starting very soon, you'll be able to expand your use of your Alfred University ID card to make other purchases across campus using "Fiat Bux."

Effective immediately, Fiat Bux can be used to purchase photocopies in both Scholes and Herrick libraries in addition to vending and retail cafes. Starting soon (stay tuned) you will also be able to use your card to purchase supplies from the Clay Store, and the Dingbat (Design) Store. You can load your Fiat Bux onto your card in Cyber Fresh Cafe and MidKnight Express.

All Fiat Bux on the card expire at the end of each academic year, so please be aware and ask about

your balances.

What's the difference between Fiat Bux and Dining Dollars?

Dining Dollars: Can be used in MidKnight Express, Cyber Fresh Cafe, Ade and Powell dining halls, and vending machines. All meal plans automatically come with Dining Dollars.

Fiat Bux: Are more flexible than Dining Dollars but must be added separately to your card. They can be used for purchases in the Clay Store, Dingbat, Scholes and Herrick photocopiers as well as everywhere Dining Dollars can be used. (In a dining facility, Dining Dollars will always be used first. When they are gone, the system will automatically switch to your Fiat Bux.)

If you already have a library card for copies or a white swipe card for the clay or dingbat stores, you are now able to stop into the Student Service Center in Seidlin Hall and receive a cash refund on the card balance. This service will be available through Feb. 1, 2010.

If you can wait a few days, we will soon let you know how to transfer the funds into Fiat Bux using your current AU ID card.
