Come Enjoy Foster Lake

Applications for access passes for the annual use of the Foster Lake facility are now being accepted. As a reminder, Foster Lake is a pay-for-use facility and everyone who wants to use the property must purchase an access pass - this includes all Alfred University (AU) employees, students, and community members.

The fees have remained the same this year and the early bird rate of \$100 for individuals and \$150 for families is valid until Tuesday, July 15, 2014. Students from AU or Alfred State College with a valid ID are eligible to purchase an access pass for only \$25.

Payments may be processed at the AU Business Office in Susan Howell Hall.

Lifeguards are on duty* from 11 a.m.-7 p.m. beginning Saturday, June 21 and running through Sunday, Aug. 17, 2014.

Please bring your access pass with you every time you come to the lake as the lifeguards will be checking IDs.
