

Saxons fall to Nazareth College

ALFRED The Alfred University men's lacrosse team was defeated by conference foe Nazareth College 20-11 Wednesday afternoon on Merrill Field. The Saxons (3-7, 1-4 Empire 8) kept it close early, keeping even with Nazareth until mid-way through the second quarter. The attack of the Golden Flyers, led by sophomore Bryan Coon's seven goals, was too much for AU to handle, however, as the squad fell to defeat. Leading AU was junior attack Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan) with four goals. Junior attack Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) chipped in with three goals and an assist, while junior midfielder Anthony Fiorelli (Endicott/Union Endicott) added one goal and three assists in the losing effort. In goal for the Saxons, sophomore Nicholas Hohman (Gibsonia, PA/Pine Richland) played most of the game, recording 12 saves. Senior Matt Jones (Waterloo/Waterloo) finished up in the nets, adding one save. In addition to Coon, Nazareth received strong performances from Jim Quakenbush (two goals and three assists) and Brandon Brown (two goals and two assists). Don Green played the bulk of the game in goal, making 15 saves. The next game for Alfred is this Saturday, April 19 when they travel to Utica College for a 1 p.m. conference game.--30--
