

AU's Miller plays defense and offense in United States Aztec Bowl victory

CHIHUAHUA, Mexico Alfred University senior defensive tackle Don Miller (LeRoy, NY/LeRoy) played on both sides of the ball as the United States defeated Mexico, 37-19, in the Aztec Bowl Saturday evening. The Aztec Bowl features a team of Division III all-stars from the United States playing collegiate all-stars from Mexico. The United States now holds a 10-1 lead in the series. Miller had three tackles and also rushed the ball three times for 18 yards. He ran for three and 12 yards for a pair of third-and-one conversions in the fourth quarter with the U.S. holding a 23-13 lead. The Americans would score on that drive to take a 30-13 lead, then put the game away with a touchdown with 3:06 left in the contest. Miller, a four-year starter for the Saxons, ran for 11 touchdowns in his career while totaling 222 tackles. He earned All-Empire 8 Conference honors all four seasons and was a First Team selection each of the last two years.
