

'Eva Hesse' Screening Feb. 8

The independent documentary *Eva Hesse* will be screened Wednesday, Feb. 8, in Holmes Auditorium, Harder Hall at 7 p.m. The event is free and open to the public.

The 2016 film, directed by Marcie Begleiter, includes new interviews, high quality footage of Hesse's artwork, and a wealth of newly discovered archival imagery. The film not only traces Hesse's artistic trajectory, it engages in a lively investigation of the creative communities of New York and Germany in the 1960s.
