Camp Convalescent July the 17th 1863
I am here in camp and feel a little
better this morning. there was two
more of our boys of our Company came
here yesterday there names are
Wilber F McGibany and
Truman Partige they said that
our Company was in Washington
yet and they had not heard where
the rest of the Regiment is yet
they tell us that our Company drew
two months pay since I was sent
up here those two Chaps were ordered
to cum up here when I did but by
sum reason they were left and they
were lucky for that for they got
their pay with the rest I cannot
tell how long it will be before I
get my pay but I shall try and
get it as soon as I can there is lots
