

AU women's swimming and diving team finishes 11th at state meet

SYRACUSE, NY -- The Alfred University women's swimming and diving team finished in 11th place at the New York State Women's Collegiate Athletic Association (NYSWCAA) championships, which wrapped up Saturday. AU finished with 308 points at the three-day championships, held Thursday, Friday and Saturday at Nottingham High School in Syracuse. Meet champion Union finished with 1,203.5 points. Senior Erin Collins (Owego, NY/Owego) placed second in 3-meter diving to lead the Lady Saxons. Sophomore Brynja Seagren (Bradford, PA/Bradford) finished 12th in the same event. Other top performers for AU included senior Jessica White (Palmyra, NY/Palmyra-Macedon), 13th in the 1,650-yard freestyle (18:45.73); junior Lyndsay Scypta (Plymouth, MI/Cranbrook-Kingswood), 14th in the 200-yard breaststroke (2:37.19); and sophomore Jessie Caccamo (Ballston Lake, NY/Shenendehowa), 15th in the 1,650-yard freestyle (18:50.56). The team of White, Scypta, Seagren and Caccamo took 13th in the 400-yard freestyle relay (3:53.83). The AU men's team competes in the Upper New York State Collegiate Swimming Conference (UNYSCSC) championship meet, Thursday-Saturday, Feb. 22-24, also at Nottingham High in Syracuse.
