ALFRED, NY – Monica Duncan is artist in residence at the Institute for Electronic Arts, Alfred University School of Art and Design, Oct. 8-12.

Duncan grew up in Webster, NY, around the apple orchards along Lake Ontario, the industry of Kodak and the tales of the Rochester Rappings. Her time-based work investigates the nature of visual and temporal perception through camouflage, stillness and the surrogate body.

Her work has been exhibited at Mousonturm, Frankfurt; The Kitchen, New York City; Parkhaus Projects, Berlin; La Casa Encendida, Madrid; 11th LA Freewaves Festival, Los Angeles; BS1 Contemporary Art, Beijing; ZKM Karlsruhe, LACMA, Los Angeles; and Marcia Wood Gallery, Atlanta. She has attended residencies at the Experimental Television Center and has been a Visiting Artist at Atlanta College of Art.

Duncan received her B.F.A. at NYSCC at Alfred University and MFA from the University of California San Diego. She is currently on a D.A.A.D. fellowship to study choreography and performance at the Institute for Applied Theater Studies, Justus-Liebig-Universität Gießen, Germany.
