

Ithaca Bombers defeat the Lady Saxons

ALFRED The Alfred University's women's basketball team fell to visiting Ithaca College Friday evening by a 80-39 score. The Lady Saxons (8-9, 0-6 Empire 8) were hurt by turnovers, committing 26 and only shooting 28 percent for the night. Leading the Lady Saxons was sophomore guard Michelle Kelly (Levittown/General Douglas MacArthur), who notched a team-high 11 points and managed two rebounds despite the loss. Freshmen forwards Meghan Coddington (Amherst/Souhegan) and Theresa Coddington (Amherst/Souhegan) each netted five points and grabbed eight and six rebounds respectively for Alfred. Leading the Bombers (13-3, 6-0) offense was sophomore guard Stephanie Cleary (Tappan/Tappan Zee) who tallied 20 points, four steals, and three rebounds. Junior guard Alex Ivansheck (Salem, Conn/Norwich) followed with 12 points, three steals, and two assists. The Lady Saxons next game will be Saturday, Feb. 1st when Alfred takes on Elmira at 2 p.m. in the McLane Center.
