

Saxons fall to visiting Knights 80-63

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University men's basketball team fell to visiting SUNY Geneseo, 80-63 Tuesday evening at the McLane Center. Alfred (0-6, 0-1 E8) shot 40 percent from the floor, but struggled from the foul line making only eight of their 17 opportunities. Freshman forward Ellis Walsh (Penfield, NY/Penfield) record a double-double as he paced the Saxons' offense with 16 points and 13 rebounds. Senior guard Garlen Patt (Nelson, PA/Elkland) netting 13 points and dished out two assists. Junior guard Carl Embury (Perry, NY/Perry) knocked down five of eight shots from the floor for 12 points and sophomore guard Jarred Patt (Nelson, PA/Elkland) chipped in with 11 points. Geneseo (5-0) had four players reach double figures in scoring with Joe Kling leading all scorers with a game-high 17 points. Jeff Howe drained 15 points while Scott Morton and Tarik Kitson scored 12 and 10 points respectively. Alfred is in action next on Saturday Dec. 8, when the Saxons host conference foe St. John Fisher at 4 p.m. at the McLane Center.
