

AU women's swimming and diving team remains 12th at state championships

SYRACUSE, NY -- The Alfred University women's swimming and diving team remained in 12th place after the second day of competition Friday at the New York State Women's Collegiate Athletic Association (NYSWCAA) championship meet, being held Thursday, Friday and Saturday at Nottingham High School in Syracuse. Alfred finished the second day of the championships with 183 points, ahead of 13th-place Clarkson (176 points), 14th-place Utica (111) and 15th-place Wells (24). Union, with 804.50 points, leads after the second day. Senior Erin Collins (Owego, NY/Owego) led the Lady Saxons with a third-place finish in 1-meter diving. Sophomore Brynja Seagren (Bradford, PA/Bradford) took 13th in 1-meter diving. Junior Lyndsay Scypta (Plymouth, MI/Cranbrook-Kingswood) placed 12th in the 400-yard individual medley. The team of senior Jessica White (Palmyra, NY/Palmyra-Macedon), Scypta, Seagren and sophomore Jessie Caccamo (Ballston Lake, NY/Shenendehowa) teamed to place 13th in the 200-yard medley relay and 17th in the 800-yard freestyle relay. The championships conclude on Saturday.
