

Utica College defeats Lady Saxons 4-1

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University women's soccer team fell to visiting conference opponent Utica College, 4-1, Saturday evening on Merrill Field. The Lady Saxons (0-7-1, 0-3 E8) jumped out to an early 1-0 lead in the 20th minute as freshman midfielder Allyson Klopp (Derby, NY/Lake Shore) scored on a loose ball in front of the net. Utica (5-1, 3-0 E8) responded with three first half goals, two of which came off corner kicks. Joanne Gueverra, and Danielle Smith tallied back-to-back goals off of Kristen Vasta's well-placed corner kicks. Smith capped the first half scoring with her second goal of the half with one minute left in the period. Held scoreless for most of the second half the Pioneers managed a late score from Jenn Woldow to seal the victory for Utica. Freshman Meredith Ragan (Dallas, TX/Science and Engineering Magnet) went the distance in goal for the Lady Saxons making five saves.
