New York recently enacted The Child Safe Playing Field Act which bans the use of pesticides on public and private school playing fields and playgrounds in order to minimize the harmful effects of pesticides on children. Additionally, the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation has initiated the "Be Green Organic Yards NY" which registers landscape businesses that adhere to an organic approach as a way of reducing their risk of exposure to pesticides while decreasing potential hazards for families, pets, and the environment.

Whether you use a landscape business or care for your lawn and garden yourself, you can have a beautiful lawn and grow a bountiful garden without the use of pesticides and synthetic fertilizers.
