

Saxons settle for scoreless tie against Oswego

ALFRED The Alfred University men's soccer team went the full distance against SUNY Oswego on Wednesday night, recording a 0-0 overtime tie. The Saxons (3-0-1, 1-0 Empire 8) were unable to capitalize on several key scoring opportunities, despite pinning Oswego in its own end for the final 15 minutes of regulation and the entire 30 minute span of overtime. The late AU offensive surge seemed destined to score as the Saxons bombarded Oswego with 32 shots on goal. Senior goaltender Kevin Ball (Wheeling, WV/Linsly School) collected five saves and remained unscored upon for the 2001 season. Oswego (2-2-1) was led by goalie John Spuhler, who had 11 saves in 120 minutes of action. The Saxons are in action again on Sunday, Sept. 16 at 1 p.m., when they host Utica.
