

## **AU ski teams compete at Bristol; Saxon women take first, men fourth**

SOUTH BRISTOL, NY The Alfred University men's and women's Alpine ski teams competed Saturday and Sunday at Bristol Mountain in a meet hosted by the University of Rochester. The Alfred women placed first while the AU men took third. The Alfred women's team won the giant slalom competition Saturday and the slalom on Sunday. For the third time in three meets this season. AU sophomore Lauren Pfeifer (Livonia, NY/Livonia) took top individual honors. She placed second in the giant slalom and first in the slalom. Pfeifer's teammates helped Alfred dominate the weekend. Freshman Elissa DeGolyer (Silver Springs, NY/Letchworth) won the giant slalom and took third in the slalom to place second in the overall individual standings. Junior Rachel Beckwith (Landgrove, VT/Stratton Mountain) was fifth in the GS and eighth in the slalom; freshman Leah Berry (Lewisburg, PA/Lewisburg) was sixth in the giant slalom and 11th in the slalom; and freshman Megan Caggianelli (Clifton Park, NY/Shenendehowa) took 14th in the giant slalom. The Alfred men's team placed third in the giant slalom and second in the slalom. The Saxons were tied atop the standings but dropped to third with the tiebreaker. Senior Lincoln Steele (Keene, NH/Keene) led the AU men's team, placing fifth in the giant slalom, second in the slalom, and second in the individual overall standings. Junior Joel Buchannon (Almond, NY/Scio) was eighth in the slalom and 13th in the giant slalom; junior Robbie Ryminski (Warwick, NY/Warwick Valley) was sixth in the slalom; and junior Chet Farnum (Farmington, ME/M. Blue) was 10th in the slalom. The Saxons are in action next weekend, Feb. 9 and 10, at Song Mountain, Tully, NY, in a meet hosted by Cornell University.
