Alfred University comes alive over the summer! Some of the "happenings" scheduled so far are:

Summer Term I courses will be ending shortly (June 22) and Summer Term II will start June 25-August 3. Summer Ceramic Workshops will begin June 18, and will run through July 22 (two, three and 4 week programs). Han Mingqi "Ghost Vessels" (206 BCE-AD 220) are funerary clay models of daily furnishings that were placed in Chinese tombs to provide replicated objects to the physical soul for use in the afterlife. Watch towers of well over a hundred extant examples can be found in museum collections with no two similar enough to categorize them into a systematic order.

Within the genre of "tower" each example shows an imaginative and distinct design, customized for the clients commissioning the works. Some are detailed with clay pigs, cows, goats, and farmers tending to their stock.

I began studying the craftsmanship and individuality of Ghost Vessels over the past two winters and have been re-imagining designs, construction, and firing techniques to (re)create architectural structures. Together, these towers offer a window into the duality of simplicity and complexity of the daily lives of the period.
