Important Notice to All Employees (Including Student Employees)

In April 2011 The NYS Wage Theft Prevention Act (NYS Labor Law Section 195.1) was expanded to require all employers in New York State to send a statement of pay rate (either hourly pay plus OT premium rate or salary), the name, telephone number and physical address of the employer, day of the week when paid, payroll frequency and whether or not there are any allowances for meals, lodging, etc. used to determine gross pay.

This notice must be sent between Jan. 1 and Feb. 1 of each year and the employee is required to sign, acknowledging receipt of the notice, and return it to the Human Resources Office prior to Feb. 1.

In the next few days, every employee will receive a statement that complies with this law. Those statements will be sent via e-mail, or hard copy for those who do not have an e-mail address. Employees who receive more than one type of pay or who work multiple jobs will receive multiple statements to assure that all types of payments are accounted for.

If you receive more than one statement you must print, sign, and return each statement by the deadline. You will also be asked to certify that you received the notice in your principal language, or if that is not possible, in English because no form was available in your principle language. If English is not your principle language, contact Human Resources for further assistance.

Your cooperation is vital to ensure our compliance with this new law. Failure to meet this requirement could have severe financial and criminal penalties for the University and could result in disciplinary actions against employees who intentionally fail to meet their obligation in this mandated legal requirement.

Henceforth, please utilize the new form that is now posted on the Public Safety, EHS and Human Resources Web pages. It can be sent to you via email request, as well.

Deliver All Accident/Near-miss forms to Environmental Health and Safety (not Human Resources) at haasec@alfred.edu or via fax 607-871-2086 immediately. Do not delay when reporting accidents or near-misses; all accidents and near-misses must be reported within 24 hours.
