

Alfred University women's soccer team shuts out visiting Wells College, 10-0

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University women's soccer team evened their season record at 2-2 by defeating Wells College 10-0 Wednesday night. The story of the game was Alfred's offense. The Saxons (2-2-0, 0-0-0 Empire 8) peppered 47 total shots, which included 25 on goal, at Well's goalie, Kimberly Jaskula. Leading the barrage of offense was Chelsea Hall (Elmira/ Elmira Free-Academy) with two goals, and Alyssa Hatch (Allegany/ Allegany-Limestone) who scored two as well. Mara Limoncelli (Elmira/ Elmira Free Academy), Melissa Polakos (Marlboro, NJ/ Marlboro), Adrienne Eglinger (Amityville/ Amityville Memorial), Jessica Brewster (Andover/ Andover), and Sarah Guest (Cohocton/ Wayland-Cohocton) each scored a goal of their own. Ellen Brandfonbrener (Franklin, MA/ Medway) and Whitney Vitale (Red Creek/ Red Creek) each chipped in with an assist. Alfred's goaltender, Brianna Paquette (West Burke, VT/ St. Johnsbury Academy), did not touch the ball until the last three minutes of the game to record her first shutout of the season.
