

AU men's lacrosse team wins third straight

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University men's lacrosse team defeated SUNY Brockport 20-9 Saturday afternoon at Merrill Field. Alfred (3-1, 0-0 Empire 8) got off to a quick start and never looked back scoring three goals to Brockport's one in the first quarter. AU concluded the first half with a four-goal lead. After intermission, AU continued to control the field, netting eleven more goals to secure the victory. Freshman midfielder Andy German (Wayne, PA/Radnor), who scored five goals and had one assist led AU. Also strong offensively was senior Dylan Marco (Camillus/West Genesee) who contributed with four goals and one assist. Senior attackman David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/mt. Lakes) led AU in points with eight after he scored two goals and had six assists. Senior midfielder Anthony Fiorelli (Endicott/Union Endicott) added two goals and Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan) and freshman attackman Jeff Andrews (Horsheads/Horseheads) each had two goals and Archer had three assists. Sophomores Adam Griffin (New Hartford/New Hartford), Carlo DiRisio (Prattsburgh/Penn Yan), and Sergio Ibarra (Buellton, CA/Midland Prep) each had one goal and Ibarra also had two assists. Freshman Chris Wszalek (West Seneca/West Seneca) played all 60 minutes in goal for AU and collected 12 saves. SUNY Brockport (1-1, 0-0 SUNYAC) was led by Mike Beach, Rob Siddell, and John Tanner who each had 2 goals. Goaltender Jim Amell played 60 minutes in goal for Brockport and collected 8 saves. The Saxons are in action next when they host Hartwick on Saturday, March 27 at 1 p.m. on Merrill Field.
