

AU men's lacrosse team drops Dickinson in season opener

CARLISLE, PA The Alfred University men's lacrosse team kicked off the 2002 season with a 14-8 win over Dickinson College on Saturday afternoon in Carlisle, Pennsylvania. The Saxons (1-0, 0-0 Empire 8) trailed Dickinson 6-5 at halftime, but went on to generate a 9-2 goal scoring run in the second half, including a 5-0 run in the fourth quarter, to close out the game and record the victory. Alfred was led by sophomore attackers Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) and David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes), who each tallied a game-high seven points. Macro's points came on a game-high four goals and three assists, while Vail's points were earned on three goals and a game-high four assists. Other top performers for AU included junior midfielder Steve Douglas (Horseheads/Horseheads), who scored three goals, and senior midfielder Bryan Bacon (Homer/Homer), who netted two goals. Rounding out AU's top offensive contributors was senior midfielder Rob Strickland (Amherst/Sweet Home) and senior attack Adam Gardner (Syracuse/Henninger), who each found the back of the net once. Also assisting in the AU attack was senior midfielder Bill Crehan (Buffalo/Bishop-Timon) and sophomore midfielder Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan), with one assist apiece. Senior goaltender Kevin Kazmierczak (West Seneca/Orchard Park) played the entire game in goal for AU and finished with eight saves. Jeremy Angell led Dickinson (0-3) with three goals and an assist. Jack Miner followed with two goals and an assist, and Trip Deeley added two goals. Sean McGowan controlled the nets for Dickinson, collecting 10 saves in the loss. The Saxons continue their season opening road trip with a game against Ohio Wesleyan on Wednesday, March 13, in Baltimore, Maryland.
