Alfred University student Taylor Jaczko of New Windsor, NY, was recently awarded a scholarship for \$1,900 from Phi Sigma Iota, International Foreign Language Honor Society, to complete a Teaching English as a Foreign Language course at the Brooklyn School of Languages over the summer.

With a double major in Foreign Language and Culture studies with a concentration in French and Global Studies and a minor in Anthropology, Jaczko hopes to participate in the Fulbright Program or the Teaching Assistant Program in France after she graduates from Alfred University in 2018.
