## Protect Our Campus, Use The "Phish Alert Report" Button

As many of you know, we have a new automated phishing prevention system. I am advising all our users to utilize the "Phish Alert Button" in Outlook (image attached).

If you receive a suspected phishing email, clicking on the Phish Alert Report button will remove it from your email and quarantine it for analysis. And even better, through your reporting, ITS systems will automatically look for similar emails on university servers and remove them from other accounts. In this way, you

are acting as a "human firewall" to protect yourself and the wider campus community from these social engineering attacks. Report with confidence...If you (accidentally) falsely report a phishing email, the analysis engine will release it back to you.

## **Idyll Currents: Jonathan Faber**

Opening Reception: Friday, November 4, 6-8pm Cohen Gallery

Abstract artist and AU alum Jonathan Faber will be showing new paintings and drawings in "Idyll Currents" a solo exhibition at the Cohen Gallery. For Faber "painting is a physical thinking process-a way of getting involved in a kind of internal dialogue. I am engaged in making works that are primarily abstract but are also connected to a lexicon of real-world imagery." Jonathan Faber received his BFA from Alfred University in 1994 and a MFA from the University of Texas Austin in 2003. His work has been exhibited at numerous galleries and museums across the country, including Cue Art Foundation, the Galveston Arts Center, David Shelton Gallery, and the Blanton Museum of Art. Among his awards are those from the Pollock-Krasner Foundation and the Joan Mitchell Foundation. Faber is currently an Assistant Professor at Texas State University in the School of Art and Design. He lives and works in Austin, Texas. Faber will be on campus for the opening of the exhibition. He will also be giving a talk on his work in Nevins Theatre on Wednesday, November 2 at 7pm.

There will be an electronic waste (e-waste) pickup in mid-November, so please take time now to gather items and inventory them, so we can tell the haulers how much to expect.

Please follow the directions below for removal of your e-waste. See the PDF for guidance on what can and cannot be disposed of.

NYSCC (statutory): Ceramic school personnel can put items in the hallways (labeled with an e-waste sign) and it will be picked up. Or you can submit a work order to maintenance for pick-up.

## **George Ferrandi : we are each other's atmosphere**

The Wednesday Art Speaker Series presents George Ferrandi : we are each other's atmosphere.

George Ferrandi is an American artist originally from Baltimore, Maryland whose performance, installation and participatory projects address issues of vulnerability, impermanence, fallibility and spectacle, often through experimental approaches to narrative. Employing a unique humor and a deep sense of humanity, her work stimulates a rethinking of cultural assumptions.

George lives with a small dog and a rooftop garden in Brooklyn, New York. She is the director of Wayfarers Studio Program and Gallery in Bushwick, and was the founding member of the touring performance project Cloud Seeding: Circus of the Performative Object. Her work has been performed/exhibited around the world - at the International House of Japan in Tokyo, at Abrons Arts Center in New York, the Kitchen in New York, Cinders Gallery in Brooklyn, the McKinney Contemporary in Dallas, the Wexner Center in Columbus, the Harn Museum in Gainesville, Fleisher Art Memorial in Philadelphia and at Sluice in London. She is an NEA fellow of the Japan - US Friendship Foundation and has also been awarded grants from the Franklin Furnace Fundwinners for Performance Art, and the Mid Atlantic Arts Council. She is currently doing the groundwork and spacework for an intergalactic festival related to the

North Star(s).

George teaches Sculpture and Performance Art periodically at Pratt Institute, at Virginia Commonwealth University and at the Rhode Island School of Design. She also runs a small business specializing in the restoration of statues of saints for churches.
