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### Herrick Library Reserves and E-res Reminder

Attention, faculty!

The school year is quickly approaching, and we would like to remind you about two very important library tools to make information sharing easier this year.

Electronic Reserves (ERes) is an important service brought to you by the libraries at Alfred University. This new tool makes faculty and students more productive by delivering selected course reserves, Internet links, and a host of other instructional materials to our campus community 24 hours a day, 7 days a week via the World Wide Web. Electronic Reserves is a password protected environment where students receive authorized access to instructor selected course materials (including traditional library reserve materials) via a customized course web page.

Print Reserves: The Access Services staff will put material on reserve at The Desk for your students to use. These materials can be DVD's, videos, books, or journals, and you may specify the length of time that the students have permission to use the materials for, as well as whether or not the materials can leave the library. This makes the materials readily available, but maintains its accessibility despite high demand and usage.

If you would like to utilize either of the above resources, please see the attached informational packets. In order for materials to be processed and ready by the first day of classes, we request that you bring materials into the library seven days prior to classes.

We hope that the AU faculty will be able to make use of these tools, and that they will be convenient and beneficial to the learning experience for the students.
