### Fourth Wingate Memorial Carillon Recital

The fourth performer in the 2009 Wingate Memorial Carillon Recital Series will be Jeremy Chesman, university carillonist and assistant professor of music at Missouri State University.

Chesman was the first person to earn a master of music degree in carillon performance at the University of Michigan. He has performed throughout the United States, as well as in the Netherlands, France, Belgium, and Portugal. As a fellow of the Belgian American Educational Foundation, he studied carillon with Eddy Mariën and composition with Geert D'Hollander at the Royal Carillon School of Belgium, where he earned a Final Diploma with Distinction.

Chesman will perform a varied program that includes Cello Suite No. 4 by Bach, many folk songs from around the world, and a setting of the hymn tune "Be Thou My Vision". The free recital is on Tuesday, July 28 from 7 to 8 p.m. All are invited.
