

AU men's basketball team falls at Potsdam

POTSDAM, NY The Alfred University men's basketball lost at Potsdam, 95-79 Friday night. Alfred (4-3, 0-0 Empire 8) shot well, making 52 percent of its field goals while going 10-for-10 from the free-throw line, but was hurt by 21 turnovers. Potsdam (6-0) outrebounded the Saxons, 40-33, and shot 47 percent on three-pointers. Junior guard Quentin Bryant (Buffalo, NY/Seneca Vocational) paced AU with a game-high 24 points. Sophomore guard Rob McCarter (Wooster, OH/Wooster) had 15 points and a team-high five rebounds, while sophomore center Dillon Stein (North Huntingdon, PA/Norwin) added eight points and three boards. Sophomore forward Ryan Clemenson (Ovid, NY/South Seneca) and freshman forward Scott Forrest (Portville, NY/Portville) each scored six points. Potsdam was led by Michael Brooks with 18 points. Edane Barton and Ernst Ducena each scored 16 points while Eldon Harris contributed 13 points and a game-high 12 rebounds. Alfred is in action next on Saturday, Dec. 11, at 3 p.m. at St. Lawrence.
