

AU women's lacrosse team falls to Keuka in home opener

ALFRED, NY - The Alfred University women's lacrosse team dropped a 7-6 decision to visiting Keuka Wednesday evening in the Lady Saxons' 2008 season home opener. Keuka (1-0) led at the half, 5-3, but Alfred tied the game at 5-5 on a goal by freshman attack Michelle Adams (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads) midway through the second half. Keuka scored two to go up 7-5 with just over five minutes left before sophomore midfielder Bailey Hebert (Heuvelton, NY/Heuvelton) scored to draw the Lady Saxons within a goal, at 7-6, with 35 seconds remaining. Keuka goalie Audrey Randall stopped a point-blank shot by Adams with five seconds left to preserve the win for the visiting Storm. Adams and Hebert each scored two goals for Alfred (0-2, 0-0 Empire 8), while sophomore attack Emily Tobin (Penfield, NY/Penfield) added a goal and two assists. Freshman attack Elyse Caldwell (Endwell, NY/Maine-Endwell) also had a goal for AU. Carrey Glover had three goals and an assist to lead Keuka, which outshot Alfred 28-20. Brandy Shafer scored two goals and Ann Shatraw and Laura Dougherty netted one each. Freshman goalie Kate Baughman (Rush, NY/Rush-Henrietta) made 13 saves for Alfred, while Randall finished with six saves for Keuka. Alfred is in action next on Wednesday, March 26, at 7 p.m. at home against Wells.
