Camp Suffolk June the 4th 1863  
I read your letter tonight Dated  
May the 30th and there was a letter  
in it from Caroline I was glad  
to hear from you and to hear that  
you were all well I am well and  
hope this will finde you all in good  
health I said that I was well I am  
a litle weak but I felt so much better  
this morning than I did yesterday  
that I did no wate for the Docter  
to return me to duty I went out this  
morning worked all day and feel  
prety well tonight I have no war  
news to tell you tell our folks that Charles  
and I are both well Richard Rufus and  
Vurnan are all well. I hope you will  
have good luck with the Cows for if they doe  
well they will be so much help to the  
famely you said that you was going to  
have Oates put on the follow it will

be better to resk Oates on it than wheat  
for it is prety late for wheat oh if I  
could be there long enough to put in the  
crops I would cum back willingly  
tell Caroline that I got her letter that  
she sent the vurees in and they were  
first rate virees to  
I have not much time to write  
tonight and I must bring this to  
a close good by for this time  
write soon my respects to all  
inquireing friends
