IEA Visiting Artist: Wenhua Shi

Date: June 22-26, 2015

Location: The Institute for Electronic Arts at the School of Art and Design, College of Ceramics

Wenhua Shi of Hamilton will be participating in the artist-in-residence program of the Institute for Electronic Arts over the week of June 22.

Receiving his MFA from the University of California at Berkely and currently an assistant professor at Colgate University, Wenhua explores the definition of code and how it relates to events and cultural form, expanding the intersection and collapsing of expanded cinema, computational interactivity, and spatial and form variations.

Wenhua will be working on an interactive audio/visual installation entitled "Reload" during his residency. "Reload" is inspired by the sound poem "Lauter Lauter" by DADA artist Man Ray, which invited the audience to perform with the poem with meaningless sounds and screaming.

"Reload" will see 71 solid, physical blocks projected upon by an image of the poem Fish's Night Song that will all contain different sound bits. The order of these blocks create different sound and visual patterns and participants will be able to rearrange these blocks in the life-size panel to create unique

experiences.
