

Alfred artist's work wins award at Wayne Art Center exhibition

Hope Zaccagni of Alfred is one of 39 artists whose work has been selected for inclusion in the 2005 National Spring Open Juried Exhibition at the Wayne Art Center in Wayne, PA. Zaccagni is a technician for the Division of Painting, Drawing and Photography and the Division for Expanded Media in the School of Art & Design at Alfred University. Her piece, "Old Friends," was chosen from among 479 entries of work from all media by artists from 19 states. It was awarded a 2005 National Spring Open Juried Exhibition Award. The 39 artists' works chosen include painting, photography and works on paper. The show opens April 9 and runs through May 25 in the Ethel Sergeant Clark Smith Gallery at the Wayne Art Center. A preview reception and awards ceremony is scheduled for 5-7 p.m. Saturday, April 9. The Art Center is located at 413 Maplewood Ave., Wayne, PA, which is just outside Philadelphia. Kevin Wixted, an abstract painter and an assistant professor of painting at Alfred University, was one of two jurors for the exhibition.
