

Alfred University women's soccer team holds post-season awards banquet

ALFRED The Alfred University women's soccer team recently held its post-season banquet, at which time team awards were handed out. Senior goalie Sara Stephens (Wayland-Wayland-Cohocton) and senior defender Lauren Hurley (Norfolk, MA/King Phillip) were named co-Most Valuable Players for AU, which finished the year with a record of 3-11-1 (1-6 Empire 8). Stephens played every minute in goal for the Lady Saxons and finished the season with a 2.08 goals against average and a .792 save percentage. Hurley started all 15 games and was named to the Empire 8 all-conference second team. Freshman forward Andrea Crandall (Almond/Alfred-Almond) was named Rookie of the Year. Crandall started 14 of 15 games and scored three goals, tied for the team lead. Her six points (3G, 0A) were second most on the squad. Freshman defender Vicki Tetro (Massapequa/St. Anthony's) was named the Most Improved Player. Tetro saw action in 14 games, starting four, and was a solid defender.
