

Publisher to present lecture at Alfred University's School of Art & Design

Dan Nadel, owner of PictureBox, Inc. (www.pictureboxinc.com), a Grammy Award-winning New York-based packaging and publishing company, will deliver a lecture, "Publishing Pictures," at 4:30 p.m. Wednesday (Nov. 29) in Room C, Binns-Merrill Hall. The lecture, part of the Visiting Artists and Lecturers Series sponsored by the School of Art & Design at Alfred University, is open to the public, free of charge. As a publisher, Nadel has produced books by artists including Wilco, Paper Rad, Julie Doucet, Trenton Doyle Hancock, and many others. He is also the editor of *The Ganzfeld* (www.theganzfeld.com), an annual book of visual culture. He has published essays and criticism in publications including *The Washington Post*, *Print*, *Eye*, and *The Economist*. He is the author of *Art Out of Time: Unknown Comic Visionaries 1900-1969* and is an assistant professor of illustration at Parsons School of Design. The School of Art & Design at Alfred University is nationally recognized as a leading school of fine arts. It is part of the New York State College of Ceramics, which is funded in part by New York State and administered by Alfred University under a contract with the State University of New York.
