

AU men's lacrosse team falls in season opener

HOBOKEN, NJ The Alfred University men's lacrosse team traveled to Hoboken, NJ on Saturday, where they lost their 2005 season opener to Stevens Tech, 23-5. After being outscored, 9-1 in the first period, the Saxons (0-1, 0-0 Empire 8) were unable to overcome the deficit. AU was led by sophomore midfielder Andy Aylward (Oswego, NY/Oswego), who finished with two goals and one assist. Also scoring goals for Alfred was sophomore attacker Steve Roff (Liverpool, NY/Liverpool) with two, and freshman midfielder Ben Coburn (Liverpool, NY/Liverpool), scoring one. Freshman midfielder Tom Argentieri (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads) dished out one assist for the Saxons. Freshmen Erick Goins (Colden, NY/St. Francis) and Dan Manti (Tully, NY/Tully) each made four saves in goal for AU. Sophomore midfielder Joe VanSickle (Hampton, NJ/The Peddie School) led Stevens Tech (2-0), scoring four goals to go along with one assist. Freshman attacker John Dolny (Mountain Lakes, NJ/Mountain Lakes) added six points (1G, 5A), and sophomores Mark Bielicky (Bridgewater, NJ/Bridgewater-Raritan) and Alex Richards (Beaverton, OR/Century) each netted three goals. The Saxons are in action next on Wednesday, Mar. 9, against Messiah College. The game will be played in Sanford, FL, at 4 p.m.
