

AU men's soccer falls short to Hobart

ALFRED The Alfred Saxons' late comeback attempt fell just short, losing 3-2 to Hobart Saturday night. The Statesmen scored two goals in the first five minutes of the game, with freshman Micke Subotowicz and sophomore Ricky Klotz each putting in one. Freshman Matt Vesonder added one more in the 24th minute giving Hobart a 3-0 lead going into the half. Alfred was held scoreless for the first 84 minutes Hobart goalie Cory Rosier, who made five saves.
