

Alfred University women's basketball team falls to Geneseo, 52-39

GENESE0, NY The Alfred University women's basketball team traveled to Geneseo Tuesday evening, where they lost 52-39 in non-conference play. The Lady Saxons (3-3, 0-0 Empire 8) were impacted by game-time injuries but played well overall, shooting 41 percent from the field. Sophomore guard Denae Foster (Canaseraga/Arkport) led the Lady Saxons, scoring a team-high nine points and grabbing four rebounds. Sophomore guard Megan Sampsell (Corry, PA/Corry Area) and junior forward Stacy Bradley (Cortland/Dryden) each chipped in with eight points, while Bradley pulled down four boards. Freshman forward Catherine Hoffman (Belmont/Genesee Valley) had a strong night off the bench for AU, contributing with seven points to go along with three rebounds. Geneseo was led by junior forward Jessica Chambers (Oneida/Oneida) who had 11 points and a team-high seven rebounds. Junior guard Jackie Fertitta (Roslyn/Herricks) also chipped in with 11 points, while senior guard Laura Talbott (Penfield/Penfield) dished out five assists.
