In 2006, a Leadership Team based in Student Affairs began working toward a unified approach to leadership education for Alfred University students.

In the spring of 2007, at the Team's recommendation, the Student Affairs division adopted the Social Change Model of leadership development. The Social Change approach is grounded in the belief that every student is a potential leader, that leadership can be learned, and that service can be an effective vehicle for learning leadership.

The Leadership Team also provided seven recommendations to guide the work of the division as we define what leadership education means (at least as far as Student Affairs) at AU.
