

Alfred University men's lacrosse team falls to Empire 8 rival Fisher, 15-11

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University men's lacrosse team lost to visiting St. John Fisher, 15-11, Wednesday afternoon at Merrill Field. The Saxons (1-4, 0-2 Empire 8) scored the game's first three goals two by senior midfielder Carlo DiRisio (Prattsburgh, NY/Penn Yan) and shut out the Cardinals to lead 3-0 after one period. The visitors outscored AU 6-1 in the second to take a 6-4 lead into the half. Alfred outscored Fisher 5-3 in the third and when junior attack Jeff Andrews (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads) scored with four second left in the period, AU had tied the game at 9-all going into the fourth. Fisher (4-3, 1-1 Empire 8) then outscored the Saxons 6-2 in the final period to pull out the victory. DiRisio had two goals and an assist to lead AU, while senior midfielder Adam Griffin (New Hartford, NY/New Hartford) and freshman attack Liam Glover (Savona, NY/Bath Haverling) each had two goals. Freshman defenseman Vinnie Terrana (Buffalo, NY/Williamsville South) and sophomore attack Ben Coburn (Liverpool, NY/Liverpool) each had a goal and an assist for AU. Attackman John Delle Donne paced Fisher with five goals and two assists while attackman Matt Hargather and midfielder Mark Schnobrich had four and three goals, respectively. Sophomore Erick Goins (Colden, NY/St. Francis) made 14 saves for Alfred, while Fisher netminder Brian Cummings had 10. Alfred is in action next on Saturday, April 1, at 1 p.m. at RIT.
