

## **Saxons drop conference road game at Fisher**

PITTSFORD, NY The Alfred University Men's basketball team fell to host St. John Fisher College, 92-51, on Tuesday evening. Shooting was the difference maker as Alfred (7-13, 5-5 Empire 8) shot just 27 percent from the floor while Fisher was 55 percent (66 percent in the 2nd). The Saxons fell behind early, trailing 27-17 at intermission and their woes continued in the second half as the Cardinals went on a 12-2 run in the opening minutes of the period. Freshman guard Jon Maroney (Lockport, NY/Lockport) finished with a team-high 10 points (4 of 4 from the floor). Senior guard Robby McCarter (Wooster/Wooster, OH) had another solid game from the line (6 of 6) and tailed 8 points. The Cardinals (16-5, 7-3) dominated the paint in the second half outscoring the Saxons 30-6. Justin Beigel and Chris Baltz led the Cardinal attack scoring 15 points each while Dan McSweeney chipped in with 11. The Saxons will be in action next on Feb. 9, at Elmira College at 8 p.m.
