

Lady Saxons lose in final seconds at Hartwick

ONEONTA The Alfred University women's lacrosse team was defeated in a close game by Empire 8 foe Hartwick College 12-11 Saturday afternoon. After falling behind by two at the end of the first half, the Lady Saxons (3-9, 0-6 Empire 8) mounted a comeback in the second half, tying the game with 39 seconds to play. The Hawks, however, netted the game winner with only 17 seconds left to grab the victory. Junior attack Chris Sanford (Bowdoinham, Maine/Mt. Ararat) led AU with a game-high eight goals and one assist. Junior attack Kelly Farrell (Meriden, N.H./Kimball Union Academy) added two goals and one assist, while senior attack Katie Sedgwick (Manlius/Fayetteville-Manlius) chipped in with one goal and three assists. Junior Jessica Dunster (Auburn/Auburn) went the distance in goal, making 18 saves. For Hartwick, Emily Dark scored four goals, while Chelsea Block had two goals and three assists.
