

2007 Tupper Scholarship winners selected

The English Division at Alfred University has selected four high school winners of the annual Lelia E. Tupper Writing Scholarship. First-place honors went to Ward Melville High School Junior Brittney Davies of Stony Brook, NY. She will receive a \$1,000 scholarship in her first year, if she applies and is accepted to AU. The scholarship may be renewed for each of the following three years of enrollment, provided that a minimum B average (3.0 cumulative grade of 4.0) is maintained. In addition to the scholarship, Davies will receive a \$50 check. Ward Melville High School Senior Claire Wilson of Setauket, NY was awarded second-place in the Tupper Competition. Her prizes consist of The American Heritage College Dictionary and The Merriam-Webster Thesaurus. Ward Melville High School Junior Natasha Field-Rahman of Setauket, NY and School of the Arts High School Junior Nicholas Statt of Rochester, NY earned third place. They will each receive a copy of The American Heritage College Dictionary. In addition to each student's prizes, each will receive a waiver of the normal AU application fee.
