

## AU women's lacrosse team falls at home

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University women's lacrosse team lost its home opener, falling 20-9 to SUNY Brockport Saturday afternoon. In the first half, with the score tied at two, Alfred (0-4, 0-2 Empire 8) was the victim of five unanswered goals, which put the score at 7-3 at the break. In the second half, despite improved defensive pressure by the Saxons, Brockport continued to pull away and outscored AU 13-6. Alfred was led by sophomore Jessica Giuricich (Blairstown, NJ/Blairstown), who recorded two goals and had three assists and senior midfielder Katie Haarmann (Ridgewood, NJ/Ridgewood), who also had five points, with three goals and two assists. Seniors Chris Sanford (Bowdoinham, ME/Mt. Ararat) and Kelly Farrell (Meriden, NH/Kimball Union) also contributed offensively, scoring two goals for the Saxons, and Farrell also had an assist. Senior Jessica Dunster (Auburn/Auburn) went the distance in goal for Alfred, making six saves. The Lady Saxons are in action next at home against Nazareth College on Thursday, April 1 at 5 p.m.
