Third Wingate Memorial Carillon Recital

The third performer in the 2009 Wingate Memorial Carillon Recital Series will be Laura Ellis. Associate professor in the School of Music at University of Florida Gainesville, Ellis teaches undergraduate and graduate organ, harpsichord, and carillon. She holds the master of music degree in church music and a doctor of musical arts degree in organ performance from the University of Kansas where she studied carillon with Albert Gerken.

In addition to her regular performances on the carillon on campus, Ellis has performed solo carillon recitals in the Midwest of the United States, in Canada, and Australia. During the summer of 2008, Ellis performed as guest artist at the 47th International Carillon Festival held in Springfield, IL.

Ellis will perform a varied program that includes "Entrance of the Queen of Sheba" by Handel, folk songs, a Spanish suite, "The Music Box" by Ruffy, and three selections from Southern Harmony. The free recital is on Tuesday, July 21 from 7 to 8 p.m. All are invited.
