

Lady Saxons fall at Ithaca 86-65

ITHACA, NY The Alfred University women's basketball team lost to host and conference rival Ithaca College, 86-65, on Saturday afternoon. Alfred (4-19, 0-12 Empire 8) won the turnover battle 24-34 but could not overcome 28 percent shooting from the floor. On the other hand the Bombers enjoyed 48 percent shooting from the floor and dominated the glass, taking a 53-39 advantage in that category. AU was paced by senior guard Meg Sampsell Corry, PA/Corry) who had a game-high 19 points to go along with eight rebounds. Freshman guards Abbey Schaffnit (Bemus Point, NY/Maple Grove) and Libby Meier (Rochester, NY/Greece Odyssey) finished with 13 and 10 points respectively. Ithaca (13-9, 9-2 Empire 8) secured a berth in the Empire 8 Championship Tournament with the win over Alfred. Tracy Bradley scored a team-high 17 points for the Bombers while Eric Steele added 16.
