

AU women's soccer ends season with a 6-0 loss to St. John Fisher

PITTSFORD, NY The Alfred University women's soccer team ended its' 2008 campaign with a 6-0 loss to conference opponent St. John Fisher on Thursday evening. Amanda Siebert gave the Cardinals an early 1-0 lead as she scored on a pass from Sarah Bihl in the 14th minute. St. John Fisher (6-9-2, 4-4-0 E8), despite outshooting Alfred 21-0 entered the half with a one goal advantage. The Cardinals continued to pressure the Lady Saxons defense in the second period as they fired off 18 shots (13 on goal) and netted four unanswered goals. Mary Dougherty tallied two goals while Joelle Joseph and Kaelyn Witz each finished with one score. Senior goalkeeper Amy Buisman (Rochester, NY/Penfiled) went the distance in goal for AU making 16 saves. On the other side of the field, Fisher used a pair of keepers, Ashley Martin and Megan Cantwell.
